

Privacy Policy

Effective as of June 26, 2020

By using Motion, you are agreeing to the collection and use of your personal information for the purposes of providing you our product services as described below. We will notify all active accounts of any significant changes to this policy.

Your data is never shared

Your privacy is really important to us. At Motion, your data, analyzed, is the product we offer back to you. We are not an ad supported company. Our free service is intended to entice you to premium service. Below are the details of this policy:

1. We will never sell, rent, or otherwise share your personal information, with or without personally identifying information. Furthermore, we will never share anonymized selections of your individual data. That includes any government (foreign or domestic) unless we are compelled by law. If we are required by law to disclose any of the information collected about you, we will attempt to provide you with notice (unless we are prohibited) that a request for your information has been made in order to give you an opportunity to object to the disclosure. We will attempt to provide this notice by email. We will independently object to overly broad requests for access to information about users of our site.
2. We may share information about user behavior in the aggregate only. For example, we could share information like, "on which days do people spend the most amount of their unproductive time online?" This type of analysis is used to enrich the product, and to represent our domain expertise to our audiences.
3. We won't spam you, ever, either directly or indirectly by sharing of email information. We may occasionally send one-time messages about important Motion news. We will likely continue to introduce ways that you can optionally have Motion contact you with data that you care about, but you will always be able to turn this on or off.

What information does Motion collect? How is it used?

If you choose to create an account with Motion, you share your name and email address. We use this information to better inform you of new features and to solicit your feedback.

Motion records the following information:

1. For time analysis: aggregate time data, e.g., total browsing time, total time spent on distracting sites, total time spent on tasks
2. For distinguishing your device: device operating system version, IP address, logged in account name
3. For improving our product: your interactions with Motion software (i.e. clicking the Motion popup, changing your Motion settings)
4. All your settings (i.e. enabling/disabling subtabs) and information data (i.e. snippets and notes) are saved securely in the cloud in order for you to access them from all devices you have Motion installed. These information are stored solely for the purpose of personal use (accessing and editing them) in Motion, and are never used for other commercial purposes or shared with anyone.

Motion does not store which websites you visit or your browsing history. In the event of a software crash (rare), Motion may record the URL where the crash occurred, for troubleshooting. Motion does not (and never will) collect keystrokes, form input, screenshots, window or page body content, or anything nefarious.

Data retention in regards to third party apps: Motion lets you integrate with third party apps, including Google Calendar, Gmail, Zoom, and others. We will retain your Personal information with respect to these apps for the period necessary to fulfill the functionalities we provide unless a longer retention period is required by law. Specifically, information such as your Google contacts, Calendar events, and Zoom meeting links are all stored locally on your browser.
