By using Motion, you are agreeing to the collection and use of your personal information for the purposes of providing you our product services as described below. We will notify all active accounts of any significant changes to this policy.

Your data is never shared

Your privacy is really important to us. We are not an ad supported company. Our free service is intended to entice you to premium service. Below are the details of this policy:

1. We will never sell, rent, or otherwise share your personal information, with or without personally identifying information. Furthermore, we will never share anonymized selections of your individual data. That includes any government (foreign or domestic) unless we are compelled by law. If we are required by law to disclose any of the information collected about you, we will attempt to provide you with notice (unless we are prohibited) that a request for your information has been made in order to give you an opportunity to object to the disclosure. We will attempt to provide this notice by email. We will independently object to overly broad requests for access to information about users of our site.
2. We won't spam you, ever, either directly or indirectly by sharing of email information. We may occasionally send one-time messages about important Motion news.

Data retention in regards to third party apps: Motion lets you integrate with third party apps, including Google Calendar, Gmail, Zoom, and others. We will retain your Personal information with respect to these apps for the period necessary to fulfill the functionalities we provide unless a longer retention period is required by law. Specifically, information such as your Google contacts, Calendar events, and Zoom meeting links are all stored locally on your browser.
